\*\* NOTE: There are no times listed. Games will follow immediately one after another. 10 minute warm-up before a team's first match (2-4-4), 5 minute warm-up for all other matches (shared court). **First matches start at 8:30 a.m.**

\*\* Each match is two games to 25, no cap. Seeding for pool play will be determined by total game won/loss record during pool play.

\*\* After pool play, teams will be seeded for a single-elimination playoff. Playoff matches will consist of a 2 out of 3 match. Games will be played to 25. Third game, if needed, to 15. No caps

\*\* The first team listed will be considered the home team for the coin toss.

### General Information

- \* Gym opens at 7:30 a.m. First matches start at 8:30 a.m. at Antigo High School (see map)
- \* Captain's and/or coach's meeting at 8:00 a.m. in the commons. At least one representative from each team must attend this meeting.
- \* TEAM ROSTER DUE AT 8:00 meeting. (roster sheet included if you have not already sent one in.)
- \* WIAA rules will be followed with the exception of uniforms.
- \* Formal uniforms are not required, but all players must have at least one, clearly visible number on their shirt.
- \* Medals will be awarded to the first and second place teams.
- \* Locker rooms will be available.
- \* Game balls will be provided. **Please bring your own warm-up balls.**
- \* Ice will be available, but please bring other medical supplies
- \* Concessions will be available.
- \* Only water and sport drinks are allowed in the gym.
- \* Spectators are welcome to attend at no charge.

### Tournament Format

- \* There are 3 pools of 4 teams each. Each pool will play a round robin. Each match during pool play will consist of 2 games to 25.
- \* Based on total win/loss record during pool play, all teams will be seeded for a single elimination playoff. Playoff matches will consist of a 2 out of 3 match. Games will be played to 25. Third game, if needed, to 15.
- \* Seeds for the championship playoff will be determined by pool play standings. Top team in each pool will be seeds 1,2 and 3. Second place in each pool will be seeds 4, 5 and 6, etc. The following criteria will be used to break ties.

#### Teams in the same pool

- head to head competition
- points scored between tied teams
- points scored against during all pool play games
- coin toss

#### Teams in opposing pools

- pool play record
- points scored against in all pool play games
- points scored for in all pool play games
- coin toss

\* A 10 minute warm-up will be provided before each team's first match (2-4-4).  
5 minute warm-up before all other matches (shared court).

**\* Each team is required to provide one down ref. and two line judges for some of the matches when you are not playing. These could be players, coaches, parents, etc. Refer to the schedule for the matches your team has to ref.**
